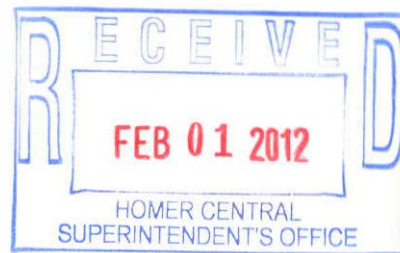

On **Friday, February 10th**, the St. Matthews/Homer Calvary Episcopal Church in Moravia will host a

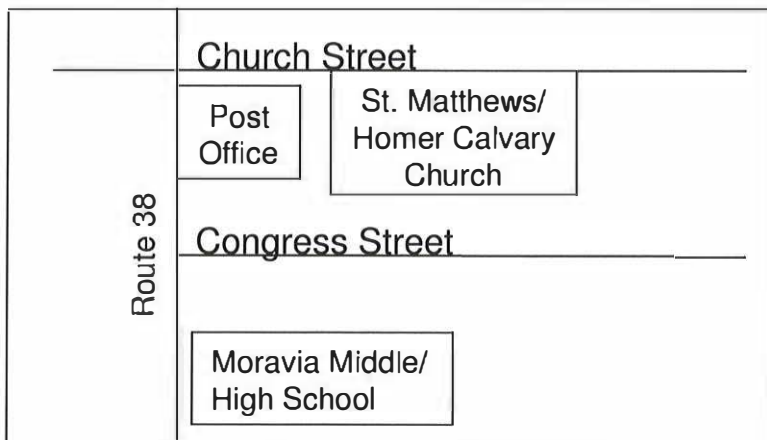


Chicken & Biscuits Dinner
