

SUBJECT: ATTENDANCE ZONES FOR K-6

Elementary students (K-6) will attend the school determined by their legal residence. The attached school district map establishes Attendance Zones. Exceptions to the attendance zones will be based on class size and program needs (special needs) only, as determined by the Superintendent.*

Appeal Process

A joint meeting will be held with Building Principals, Director of Special Education (if needed), Transportation Supervisor and Superintendent of Schools. Parents will present the specific details of their appeal to this group. The group will render a written decision to the parents within seven working days.

Mid-Year Residence Change

If a family moves within the district during the school year, the following criteria will be used to determine the placement for the remainder of the year:

- a) Class size* */program needs.
- b) Parent request will be honored based on the district's or parent's ability to arrange transportation within the current busing schedule.

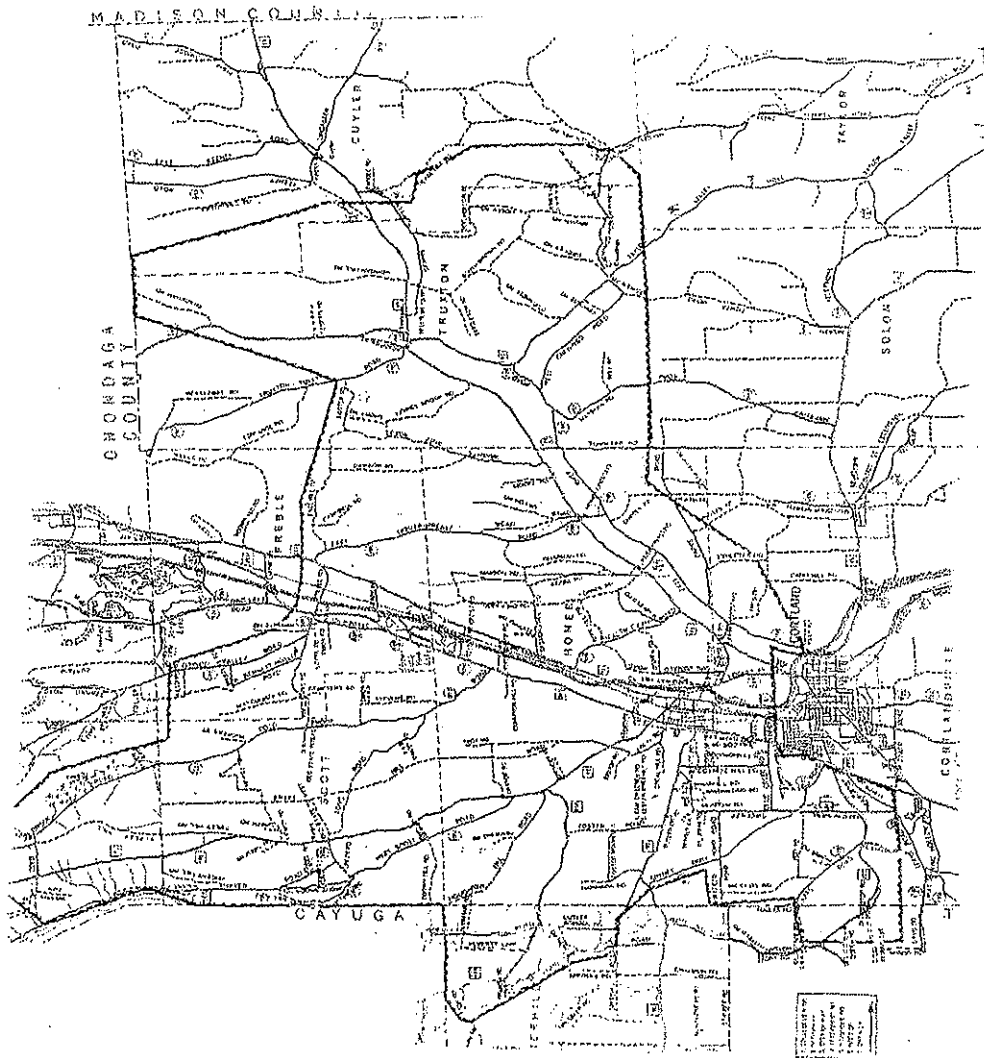
At the start of the following school year, the student will attend the school in the zone where they legally reside.

'Children that have been placed prior to the adoption of this policy will be grandfathered as long as their legal residence remains the same. If the family changes legal residence, their placement will be governed by this policy.

**The Building Principal, in consultation with the Superintendent of Schools, will determine maximum class size.
