

HOMER CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT'S LEAD AGENCY RESOLUTION  
PURSUANT TO THE NEW YORK STATE  
ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT

WHEREAS, the Homer Central School District Board of Education (the "District") will be considering the impact on the environment in accordance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations ("SEQRA") of a capital improvement project which will involve significant work at several campuses containing District facilities (hereinafter such project may be referred to as "the 2013 Capital Project"), and

WHEREAS, the 2013 Capital Project will include significant upgrades, renovations and expansion of District facilities, including but not limited to the following: 1. at the Homer Senior High School the expansion and renovation of the gymnasium and relocation rebuilding of athletic fields at the site, significant remodeling of current facilities inside of buildings on site, including renovation of existing art rooms, music rooms, and the auditorium and renovation of toilet rooms, installation of HVAC (heat, ventilation, and air conditioning systems) upgrades and installation of ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) upgrades to improve accessibility for various facilities, as well as upgrades to the High School Press Box, among other work; and 2. at the Homer Intermediate-Junior High School, network and data system upgrades and the addition of a baseball field, replacement of damaged sidewalks and ADA upgrades, configuring the bus loop adjacent to the music addition, among other work; and 3. at the Homer Music Building and Bus Garage, renovation of existing music rooms into district offices, installation of new toilet rooms and kitchenette, installation of HVAC system upgrades and electrical system upgrades among other work; and 4. at the Homer Elementary School and the Hartnett Elementary School similar upgrades as referenced above for other District campuses including ADA upgrades, network data system upgrades as more fully set forth in the 2013 Capital Project plans located at the District's administrative offices and which shall be identified in part 1 of the Long Environmental Assessment Form which is being prepared for the 2013 Capital Project (as more fully detailed below). The District has preliminarily categorized the 2013 Capital Project as an unlisted action under applicable law including the SEQRA regulations, and

WHEREAS, the District directs that the District Superintendent as appropriate, together with District staff and District consultants prepare the referenced Part I of the Long Environmental Assessment Form ("Part 1 of the EAF") provided under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act for the 2013 Capital Project, and

WHEREAS, the District directs that the Superintendent and/or staff, to notify as appropriate involved and interested agencies of the District's intent to act as lead agency for the 2013 Capital Project by directing Part 1 of the EAF to be mailed to appropriate agencies and others under applicable regulations notifying them of the District's intent to

act as lead agency for the 2013 Capital Project and of the District's intent to conduct a coordinated review of the 2013 Capital Project;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the District shall direct that Superintendent or staff to transmit Part 1 of the EAF for the 2013 Capital Project to each of the involved agencies at issue and other agencies as deemed appropriate signifying the District's intent to act as lead agency for the 2013 Capital Project and to conduct a coordinated review of such project in accordance with 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 617.1 *et seq.* of the implementing regulations under the New York state Environmental Quality Review Act as well as Article 8 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law, and as long as there are no objections lodged by any involved agencies after Part I of the EAF is so transmitted than the District shall be installed as lead agency for the coordinated environmental review 2013 Capital Project in accord with applicable regulations, and

This resolution shall be effective immediately.
