

**THE HOMER CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT'S  
RESOLUTION CONCERNING A PROPOSED ACTION AT  
THE SCHOOL PURSUANT TO THE NEW YORK STATE  
ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT**

WHEREAS, the Homer Central School District Board of Education (the “District”) has considered the impact on the environment of the proposed action which includes the following work at the Homer Senior High School Girl’s Locker Room and Math Room # 43 at the Homer Senior Highschool, including: the proper handling, removal and disposal of approximately 1,600 square feet of asbestos containing material including ceiling tile, plaster ceiling and grid cleaning in the Girl’s Locker Room and the proper handling, removal and disposal of approximately 900 square feet of asbestos contaminated material ceiling tile and other material from Math Room # 43 as well as any sampling, and/or testing as may be required in accordance with applicable law and regulations for the handling, and disposal of such material in order to prevent further damage to property and to prevent potential injury and to properly maintain and update the referenced facilities (the “Project”), and:

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law and procedure, the District has reviewed the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act, Article 8 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law and its applicable regulations 6 NYCRR 617 et. seq. (“SEQRA”), to determine the type of SEQRA review which might be required for the Project, if any;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Homer Central School District Board of Education resolves as follows:

1. The District has determined that the Project entails routine activities of an educational institution, and/or replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a facility, and if further has determined the Project constitutes an emergency action as it must be undertaken as soon as practicable to address damage to property and to avoid injury and damage to the environment given the discovery of asbestos containing materials which much be addressed in accordance with applicable law as identified above, and the work to be performed on the Project will be undertaken in a manner so as to address the need identified including to prevent further damage and avoid potential injury and will be performed in a manner to avoid impact to the extent possible, and thus under 6 NYCRR 617.5 it is deemed to be a Type II Action under SEQRA.
2. As a Type II Action, the Project is not subject to review under SEQRA as it is deemed to not have a potential significant impact on the environment.
3. The requirements of SEQRA have been satisfied.
