SUBJECT: INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS: DRIVER EDUCATION, GIFTED AND TALENTED EDUCATION AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION**Driver Education**

A driver education course may be offered under the conditions set forth by the New York State Education Department and Commissioner's Regulations. Homer Central School District requires students to hold a valid permit in order to participate in a District offered program.

The Board of Education will provide appropriate educational programs for students identified as being gifted and talented.

Physical Education Class

All students, except those with medical excuses, shall participate in physical education in accordance with the Commissioner's Regulations. An excuse from physical education class may be accepted from a licensed physician or licensed chiropractor. Any student whose condition precludes participation in a regular program shall be provided with adaptive physical education approved by the Commissioner of Education.
