OCM BOCES Regional Summer School Program for the summer of 2013 has officially come to the end with this summative report! In the spirit of continuous improvement, we made minor adjustments to Regional Summer School and plan to continue to reflect on this program to make the changes that will contribute to greater effectiveness and efficiency. In preparation for 2014 we will be employing several formal paths to collect feedback from all of our districts. Suggestions will be incorporated going forward. If at any time you have any suggestions please let me know. We do this service for *your* kids!

One change you might notice is the format of this report. We have condensed the report while also including information about pass rate that was not previously included. All districts were sent their individual data through email on August 22, 2013 listing how each student performed. It is the summary report that is attached.

Some of the other improvements that were made to Regional Summer School:

- Creation and Implementation of Math 7 and Math 8 Summer School Curriculum aligned to the Common Core Learning Standards
- All sites included grades 7-12
- Creation and Implementation of an Attendance Policy
- All forms, calendar, brochures, and contact information for all sites were available on the updated Regional Summer School website
- Alignment of a Teacher Evaluation system that is now aligned with the NYS Teaching Standards
- Administration teams consisted of 2 certified administrators and 2 administrative interns

Twenty-one districts participated in Regional Summer School. The table below shows the total students who participated at each of the four sites.
