Schools that need LAPs



- Have not made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for certain subgroups for more than two years.
- HIS – students with disabilities
- HJH– students with disabilities
- HEL– economically disadvantaged

Requirements for LAP Schools in Districts in Good Standing

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- Complete the Diagnostic Self-Review Document and Report Template (DRSDRT) for each identified LAP school
- Get Board approval of the self-review documents
- Post approved self-review documents to the district's website by November 22, 2013

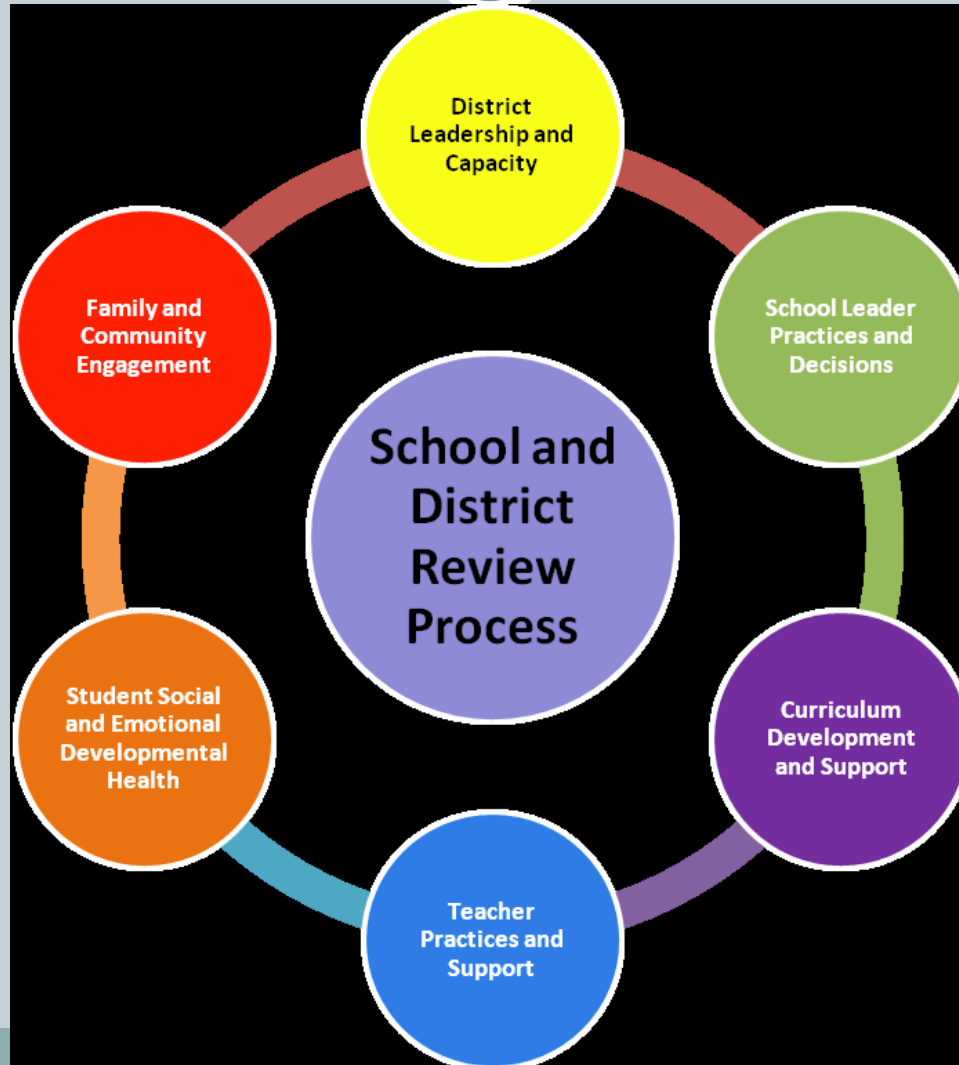
Completing the Diagnostic Self-Review

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1. Review the Tenets and Statements of Practice, particularly as they relate to the identified subgroup(s)
2. Collect Evidence
3. Assign Ratings
4. Create Action Plan(s)
5. Collaborate with District
6. Get Board of Education Approval
7. Share the Plan

Six Tenets of Effective Schools and Districts

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Creation of Action Plan(s)

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- Rubric ratings can be Highly Effective, Effective, Developing, and Ineffective. For all ratings *except* highly effective, the school must create an action plan.
- The action plan must describe:
 - Actions that will be taken or have recently been taken to improve the identified subgroup(s) student performance levels
 - District resources to be used or that are being used to implement the actions in this area
 - Professional development activities planned to support the implementation of the actions.

Sharing the Plan

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- The Self-Review is completed by the school leadership team and in collaboration with district representatives.
- The Self-Review must be posted, along with evidence of Board approval, to the district's website, no later than November 22, 2013.
- The Self-Review must also be kept on file at both the school and district offices.
