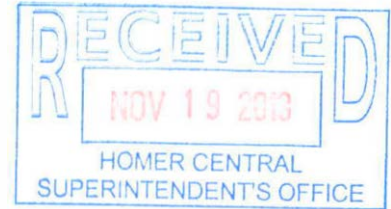
Regarding: 2015 Language Trip to Costa Rica

Dear Homer Board of Education:

Homer High School has had the privilege of offering a Study Abroad Program like no other for many years now. In 1994 I traveled with sixteen of our upper-level Spanish students to Morelia, Mexico. They lived with host families, toured the countryside, and attended school. Just yesterday I had a conversation with a parent of one of those students and she informed me that their family still keeps in touch with the family her daughter stayed with in Mexico. Since that year I have coordinated and chaperoned over fourteen Study Abroad trips for our high school students. The past nine programs have taken place in San José, Costa Rica. My experience over the years has been put to great use and I am confident that the itinerary and overall experience for our students are like no other offered. The students live with wonderful host families, enjoy the beautiful culture and countryside of Costa Rica and most importantly attend a language institute daily where their Spanish skills can be perfected.

Having said this, I would greatly appreciate your continued support. I would like to begin my year long process of planning by holding informational meetings with any upper-level Spanish students interested. We will discuss possible plans of a Costa Rica Study Abroad trip in the year 2015. *(I have included a sample itinerary from the past)* If there is enough interest I will then schedule a Parent Informational Meeting where I will discuss in detail the program. The cost of the program has ranged from \$2,000 - \$2,200. This includes all expenses. While it is almost impossible for a Homer student to fundraise the entire amount; the International Club does offer a limited number of opportunities and through the years parent groups have organized some activities as well.

A program of this nature takes many months of planning. With your permission I would like to begin the process and continue to inform you of the plans as they are solidified.

Thank you again for your support. I look forward to sharing this experience of a lifetime with some of Homer's finest students.
