

SUBJECT: INSTRUCTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS**Grouping for Instruction**

As far as possible, teachers shall provide children of all abilities full and adequate opportunity for maximum achievement, and this may be facilitated by grouping.

Organization for Instruction

Instructional methods may vary from customary practices if in the opinion of the Superintendent and his/her staff variation will increase student learning by providing better learning situations, and if such instruction more effectively meets individual needs.

Class Size

The Superintendent shall submit for Board consideration figures for the maximum and minimum limits of class size of each of the grades. Such recommendations shall include modifications in the case of experimental programs, certain course sequence requirements and predicted future enrollment. The administration shall try to maintain classes equal to or smaller than the maximum limits set up by the New York State Education Department.
