

**THE HOMER CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT’S RESOLUTION  
FINDING THAT CERTAIN UPGRADES AND RENOVATIONS  
CONSTITUTE A TYPE II ACTION UNDER THE NEW YORK  
STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Homer Central School District (the "District") acting through its Board of Education has proposed certain technology and equipment upgrades and lighting replacement at the Homer Intermediate-Junior High School as more fully set forth in the plans on file at the District’s administrative office (the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act Article 8 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law and associated regulations including 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.1 et seq. ("SEQRA") the District is required to undertake a review of potential environmental impacts associated with the Project and in consultation with its consultants and counsel, the District has determined that the Project constitutes a Type II Action under SEQRA as defined under 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.5 (c) and subparts thereunder, because the Project is comprised of maintenance or repairs, replacement and/or reconstruction in kind, and the routine activities of an educational institution and the Project components do not otherwise meet criteria as a Type I or Unlisted Action.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**

Based on the foregoing, the District finds that the Project is exempt from SEQRA as a Type II action under applicable regulations and thus no significant adverse environmental impact will result from the Project.
