The Homer Elementary PTO plans to hold a Walk-A-Thon on May 20, 2016. This would be our 2nd year of hosting the Walk-A-Thon. The intermediate school SCA would also like to partner with us and hold a Walk-A-Thon on the same day. We would join forces on sponsorship to cover the cost of Homer pride t-shirts for the students.
