### I. ILC Membership and Responsibilities

1. A list of potential members was proposed and discussed at length in order to ensure all areas of staff, paraprofessional, administration, and parents need representation but the committee size needs to stay manageable.

### II. Course Proposals for 2016-2017

1. English is proposing three ½ year courses: Intro to Poetry, Journalism, and Screenwriting. Some discussion followed about language that needed to be clarified as well as credits earned counting for elective vs 4th credit in English. These decisions will be made at the guidance and department meetings.
2. Math is proposing Statistics in Sports. Discussion followed about the name being of interest to students but “Sports” making the course not an accreditable course for NCAA.
3. Music has suggested a course deletion and some clarification of extra curricular offerings
4. Extracurriculars are not listed with every subject. We need consistency in this area; they should be listed with each subject or a separate document should be created.
5. Foreign Language is proposing a department name change to World Languages as many in the state are moving in that direction.
