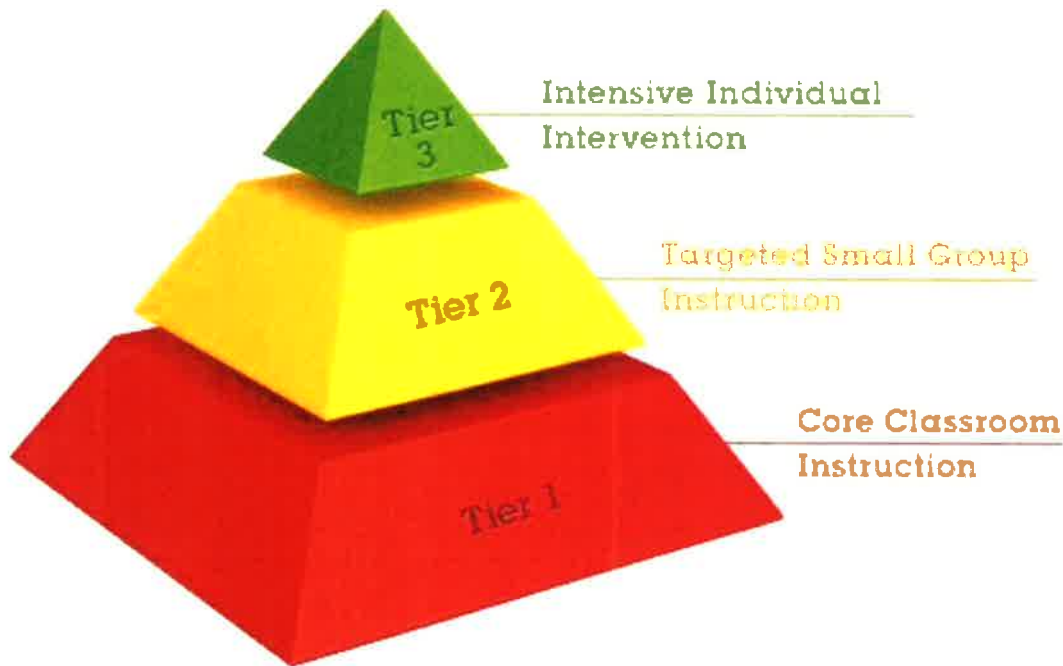

RTI at the **Elementary School**

- Core based interventions that align to everyday instruction that meet students needs based on where they are at within the curriculum.
- Assessment and Remediation guides provided by CKLA.
- AIS math provider meeting with groups of students who may be deficient in mathematic skills. Also meets with students who are beyond the core curriculum.



RTI at the Intermediate School

- Menu of interventions for tier 2-3 students chosen by multiple measures including FastBridge, NYS assessments, CKLA assessments, and classroom performance.
- Opportunities for students in tier 1 to further explore ELA topics with peers
- AIS math provider meeting with groups of students in grade 3 who may be deficient in mathematic skills. Also meets with students who are beyond the core curriculum.



RTI at the **Junior High**

- Menu of interventions for tier 2-3 students chosen by multiple measures including FastBridge, NYS assessments, and classroom performance. Includes Reading and Mathematics intervention groups.
- Full implementation for both grade six and seven students.
- Eighth grade implementation being planned for 2018-2019. Additional social/emotional interventions being explored for use.
