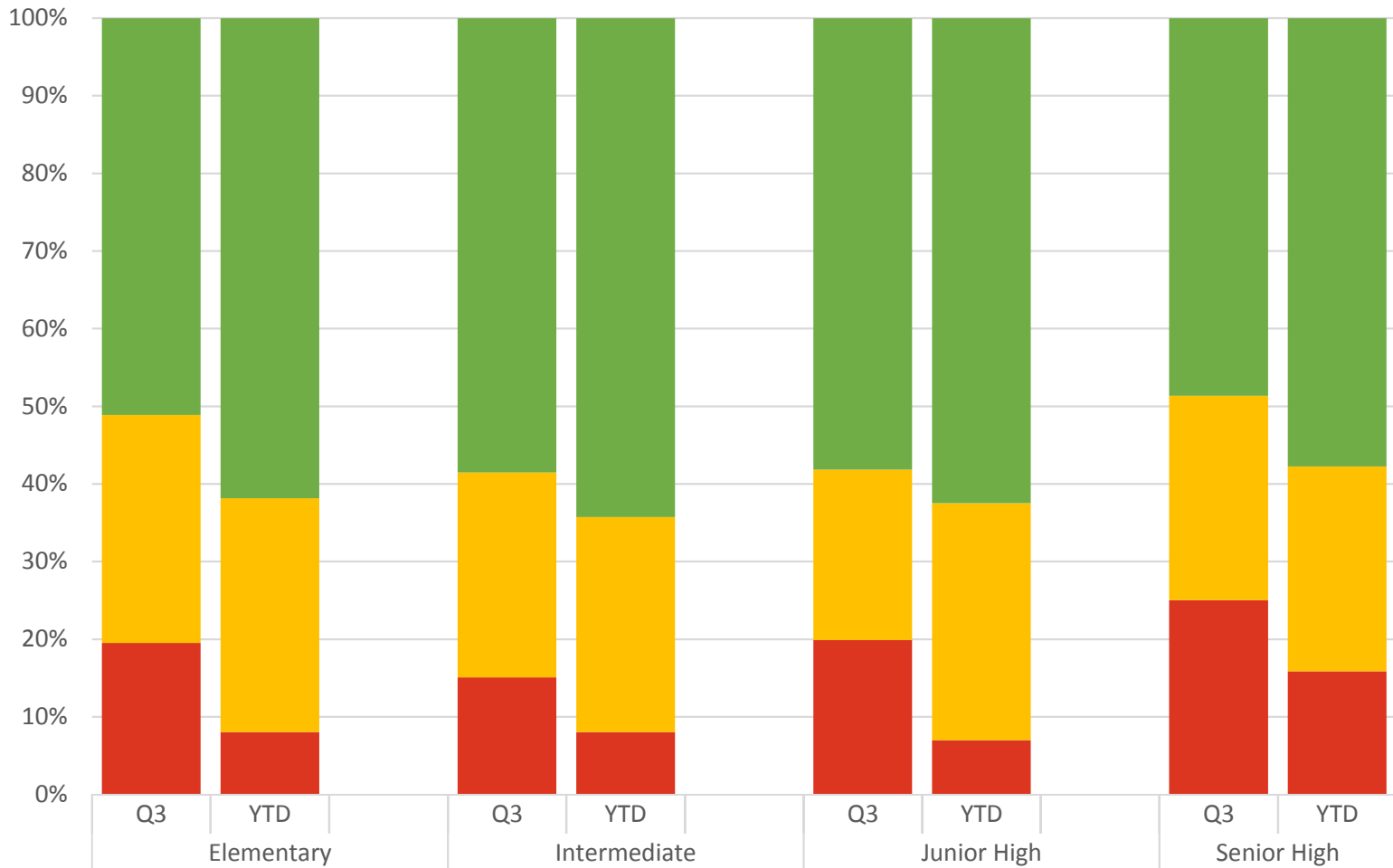

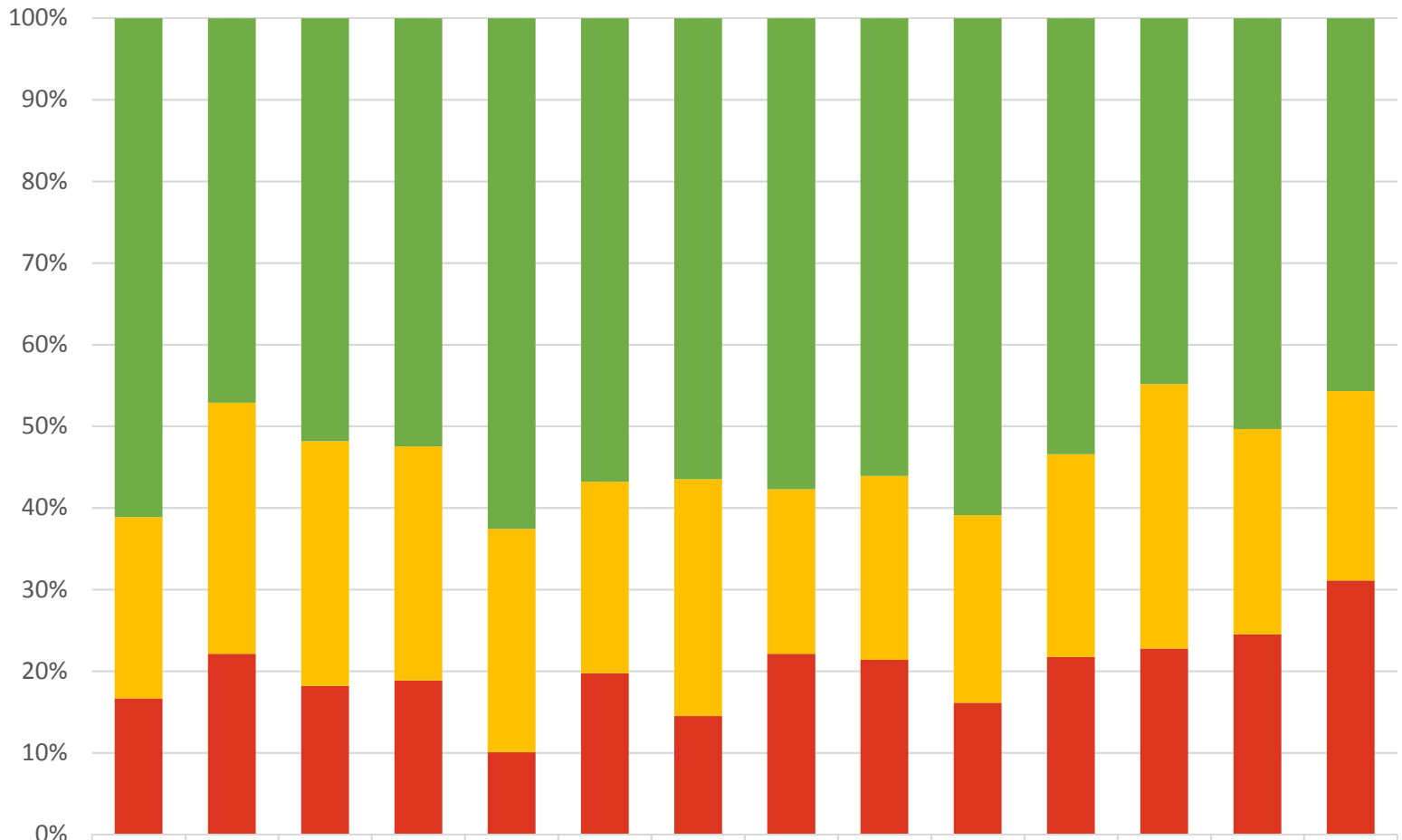

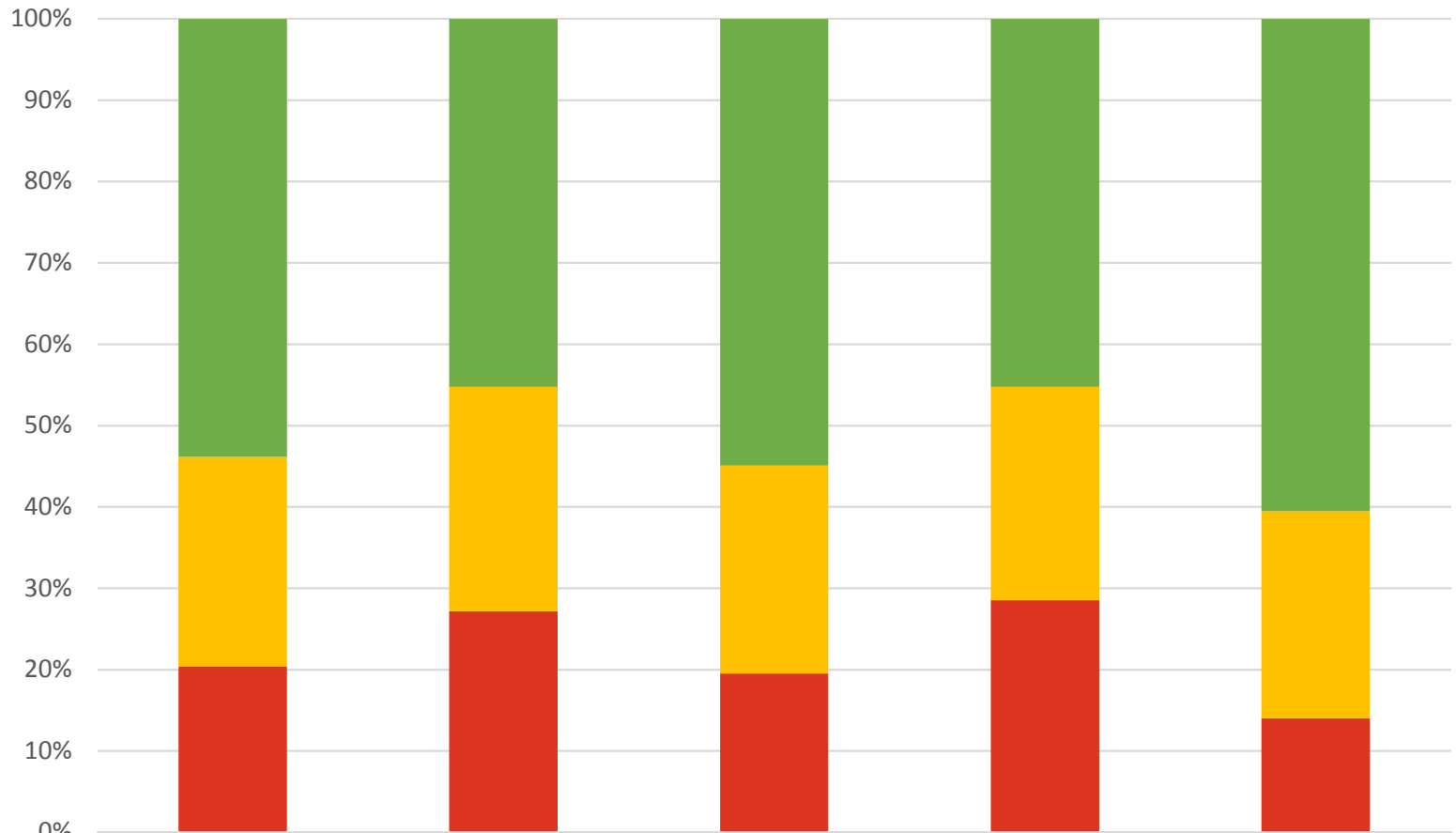

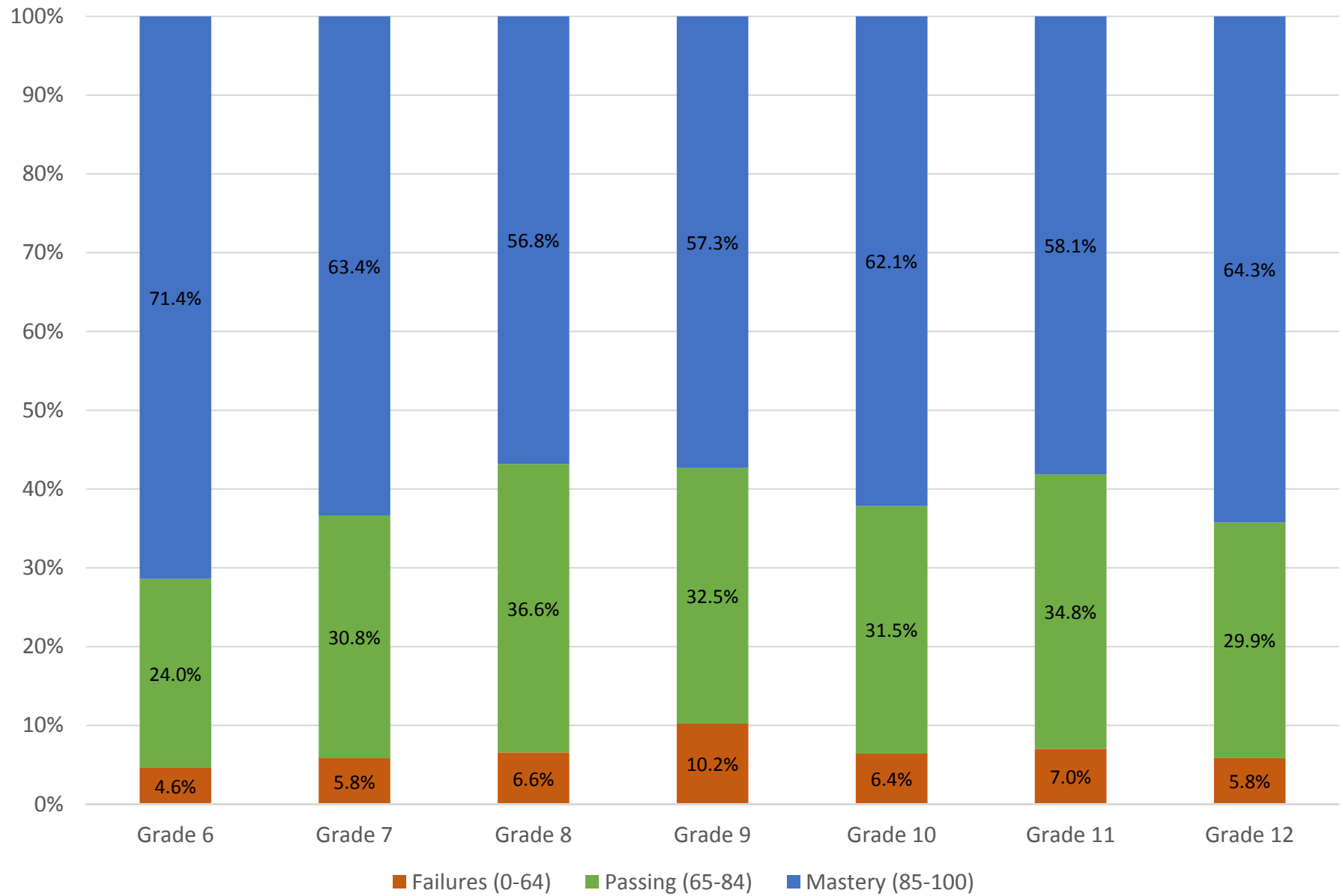

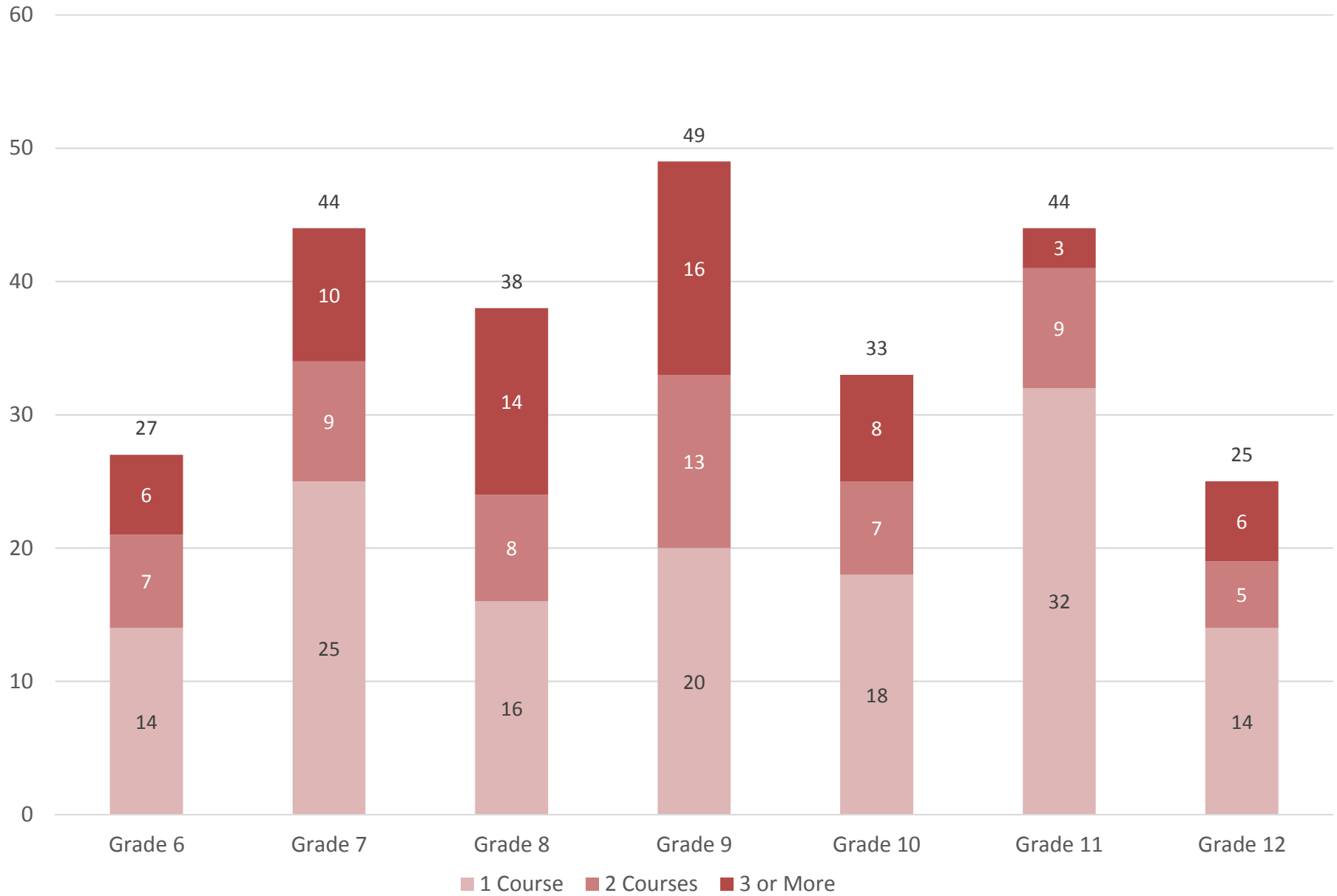

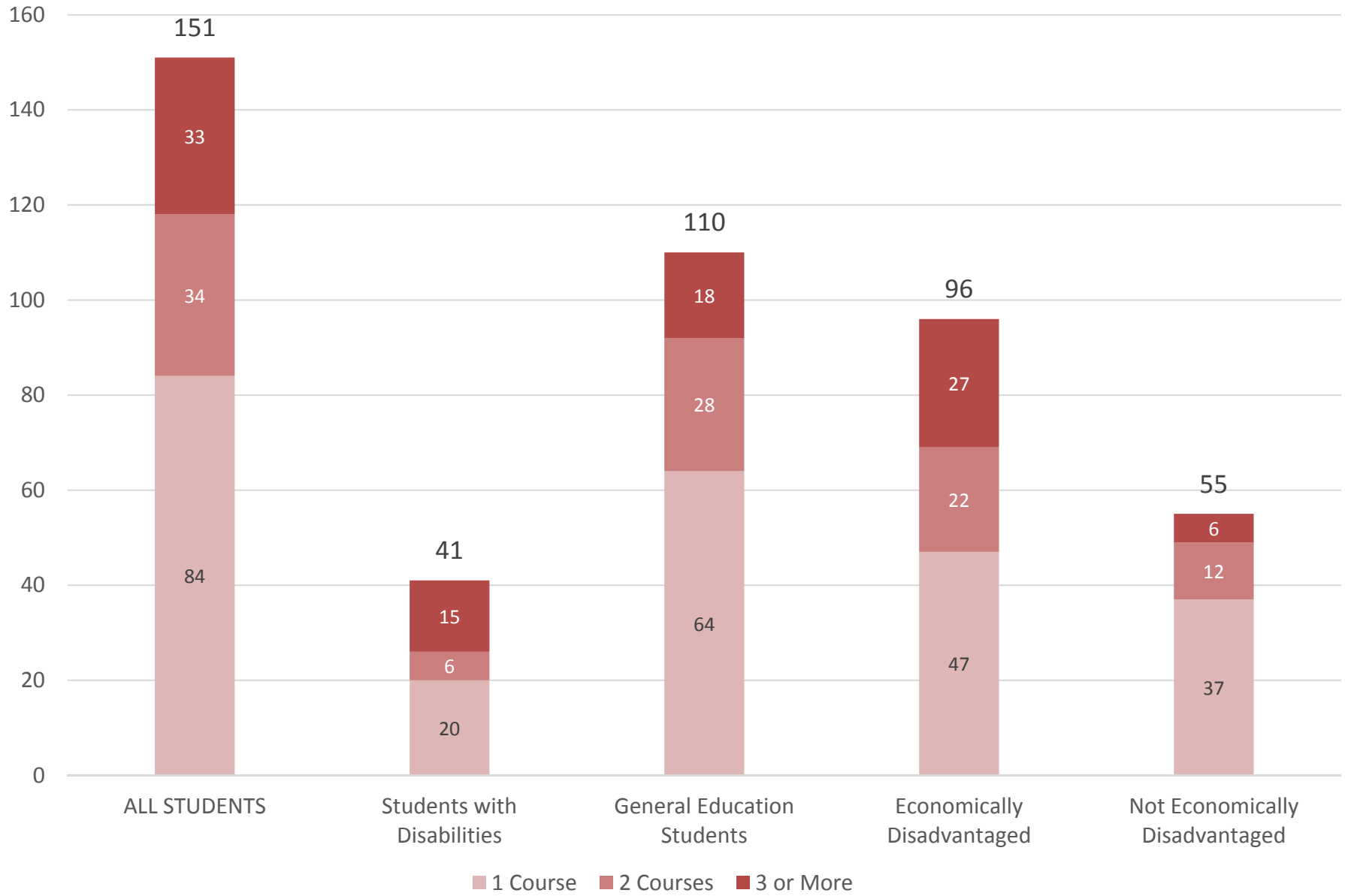
17-18 Q3 - JH - Number of Students Failing Courses - by Quarter



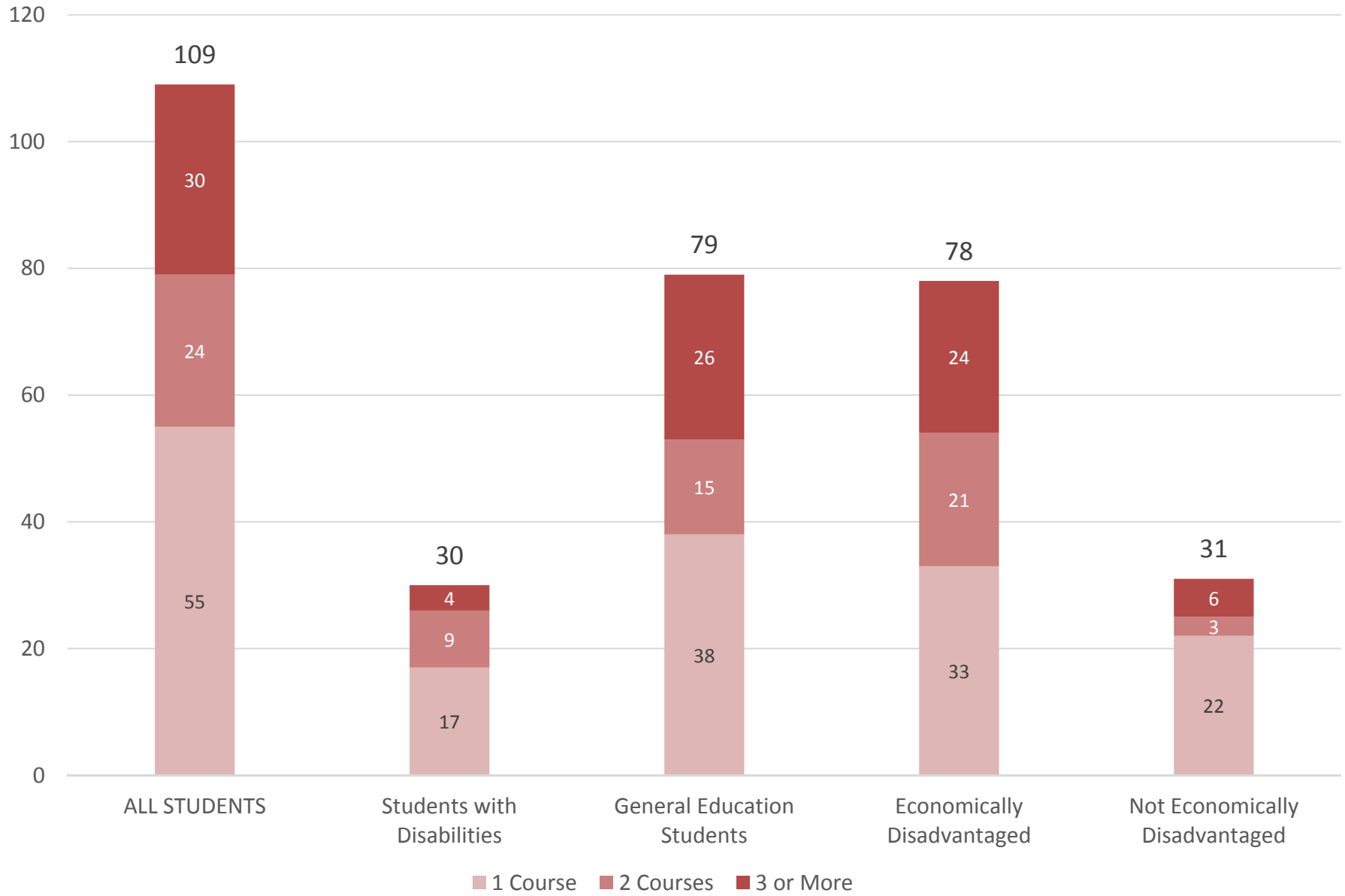
17-18 Q3 - Number of Students Failing Courses - by Grade Level



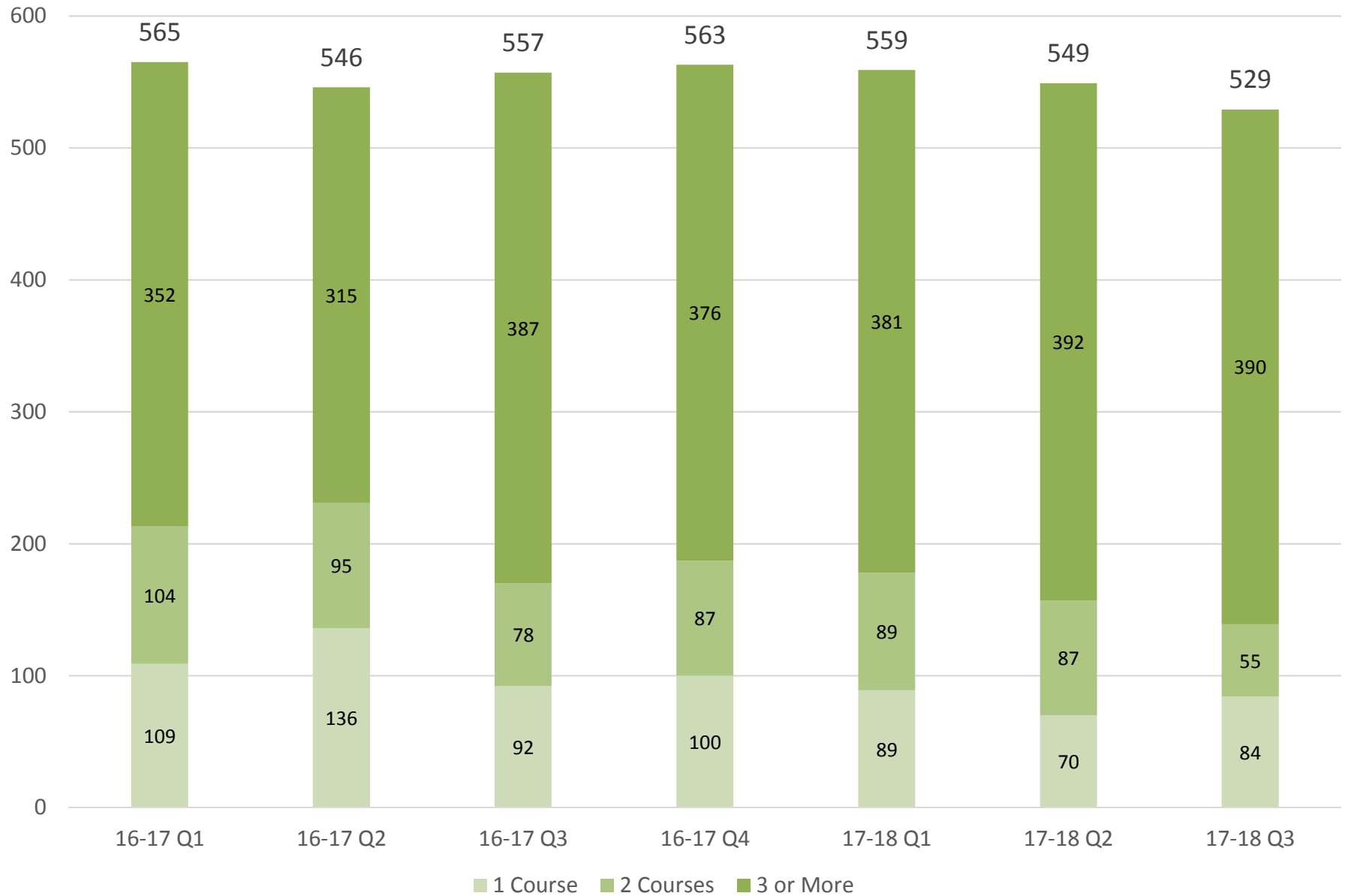

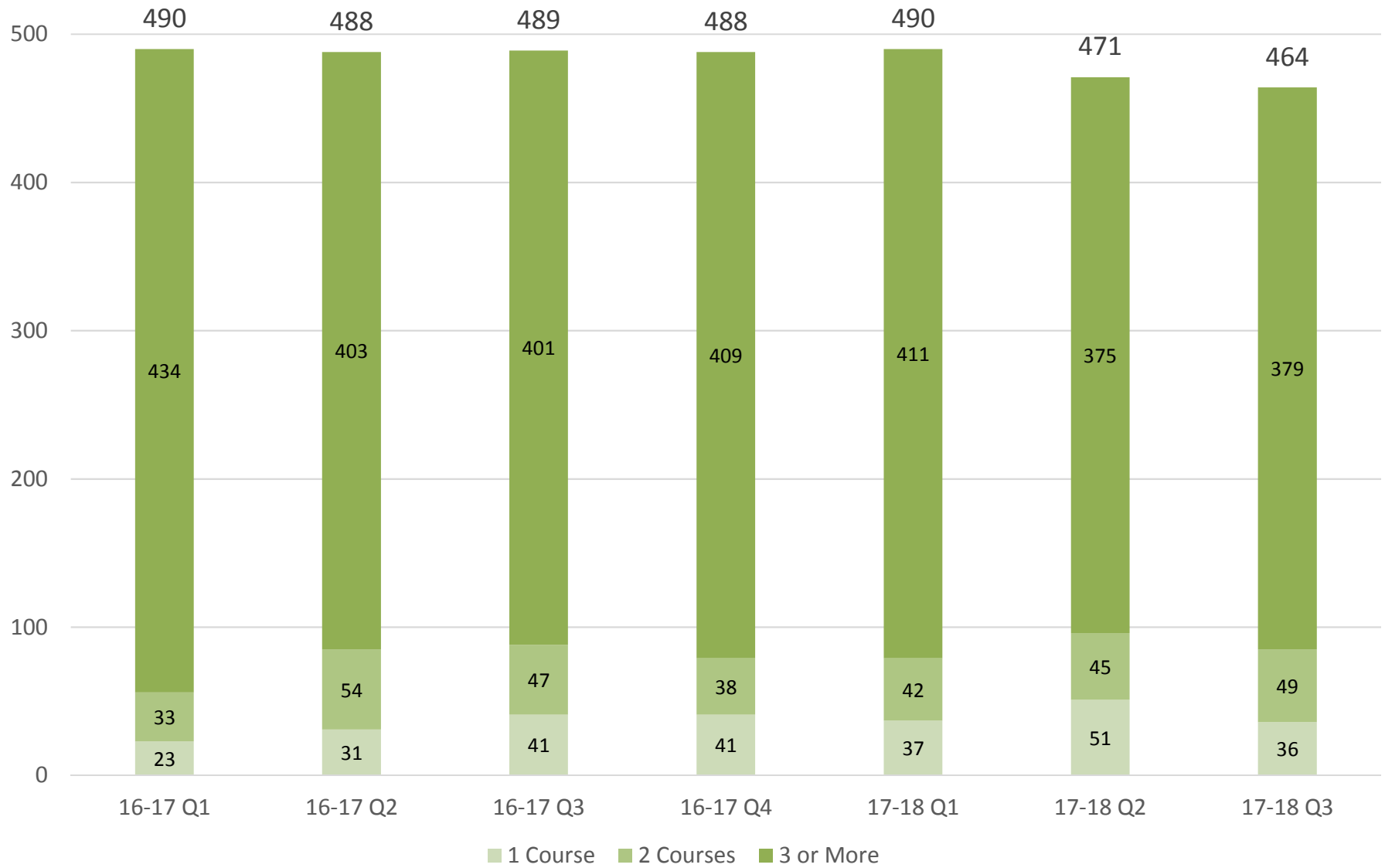

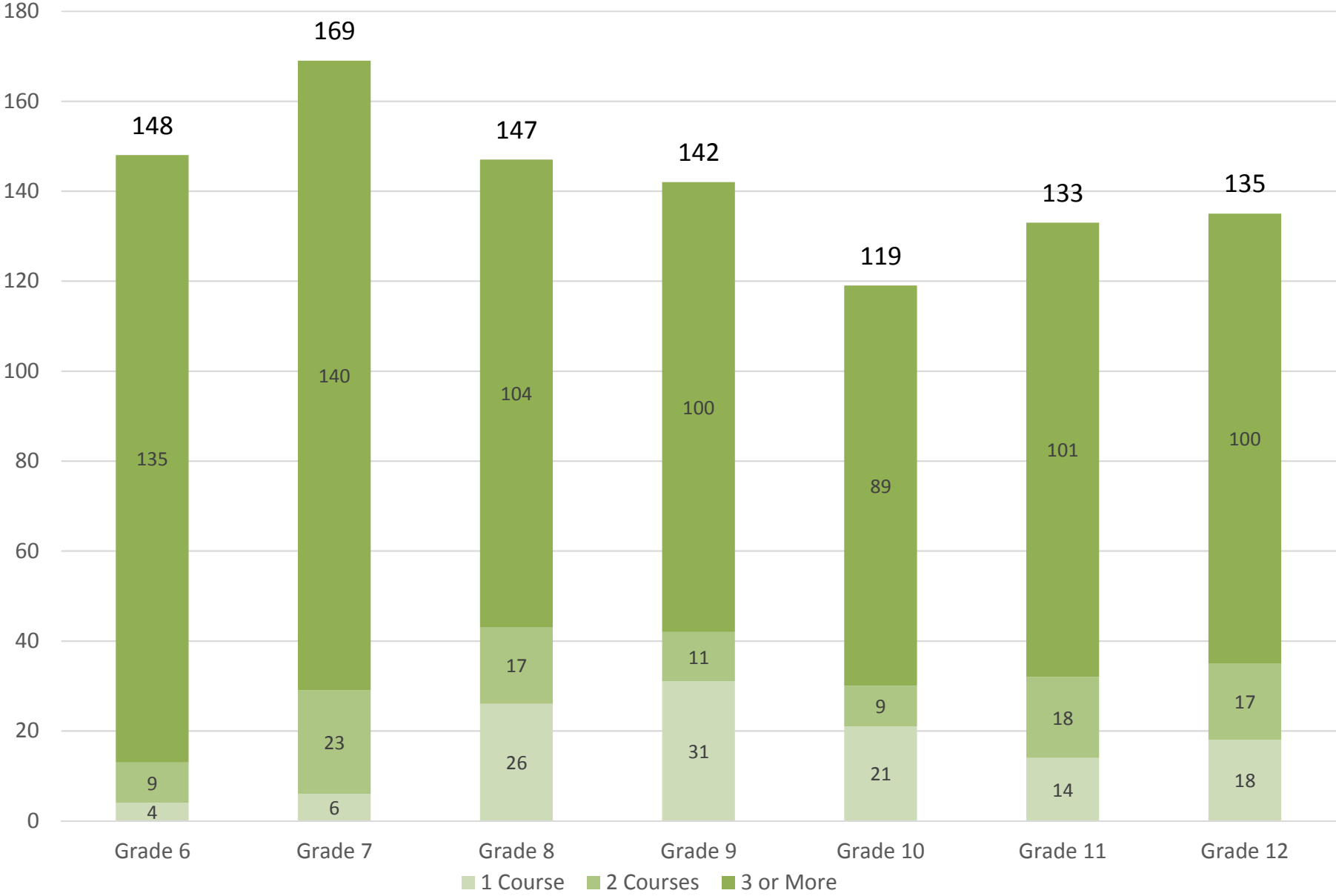

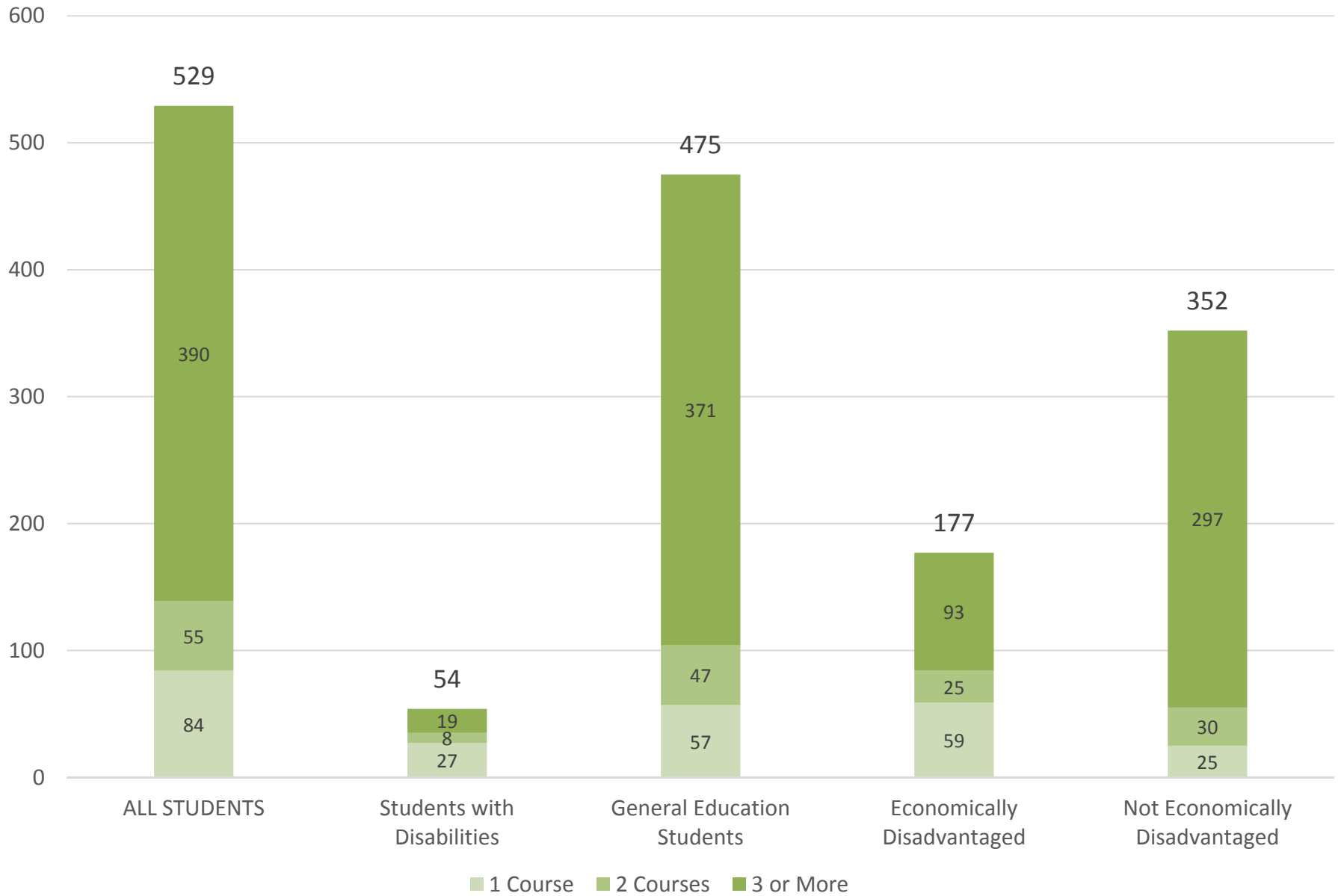

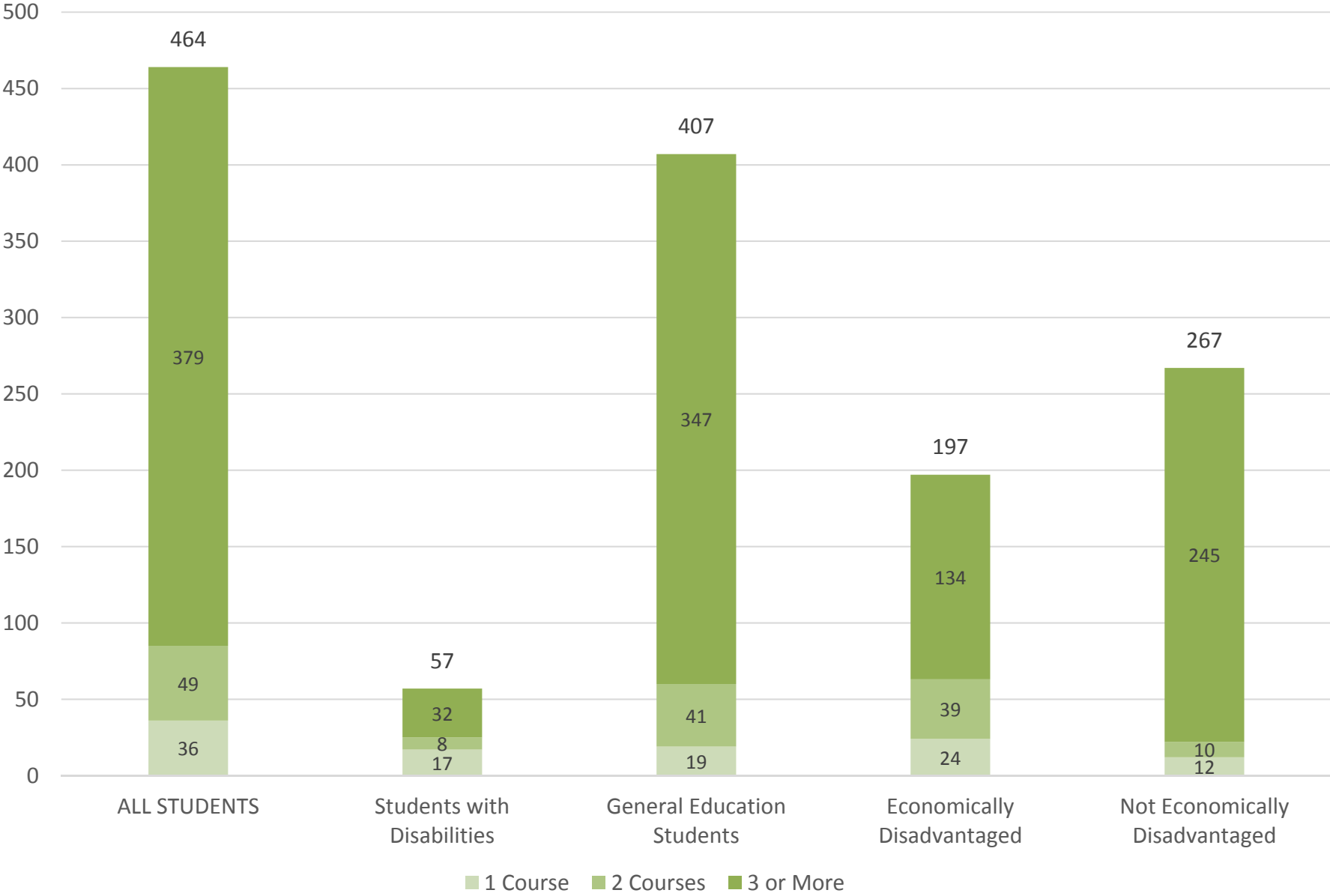

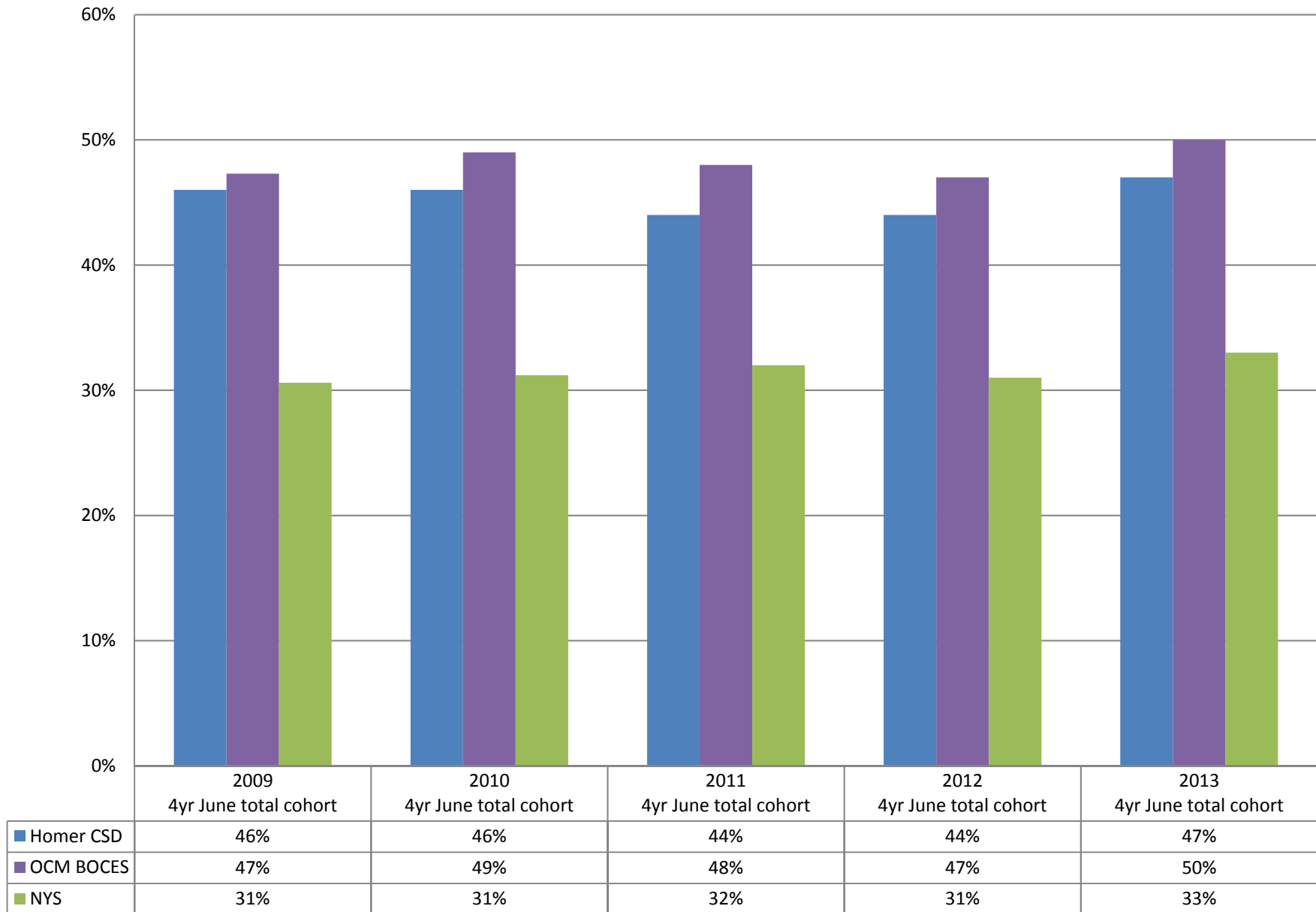

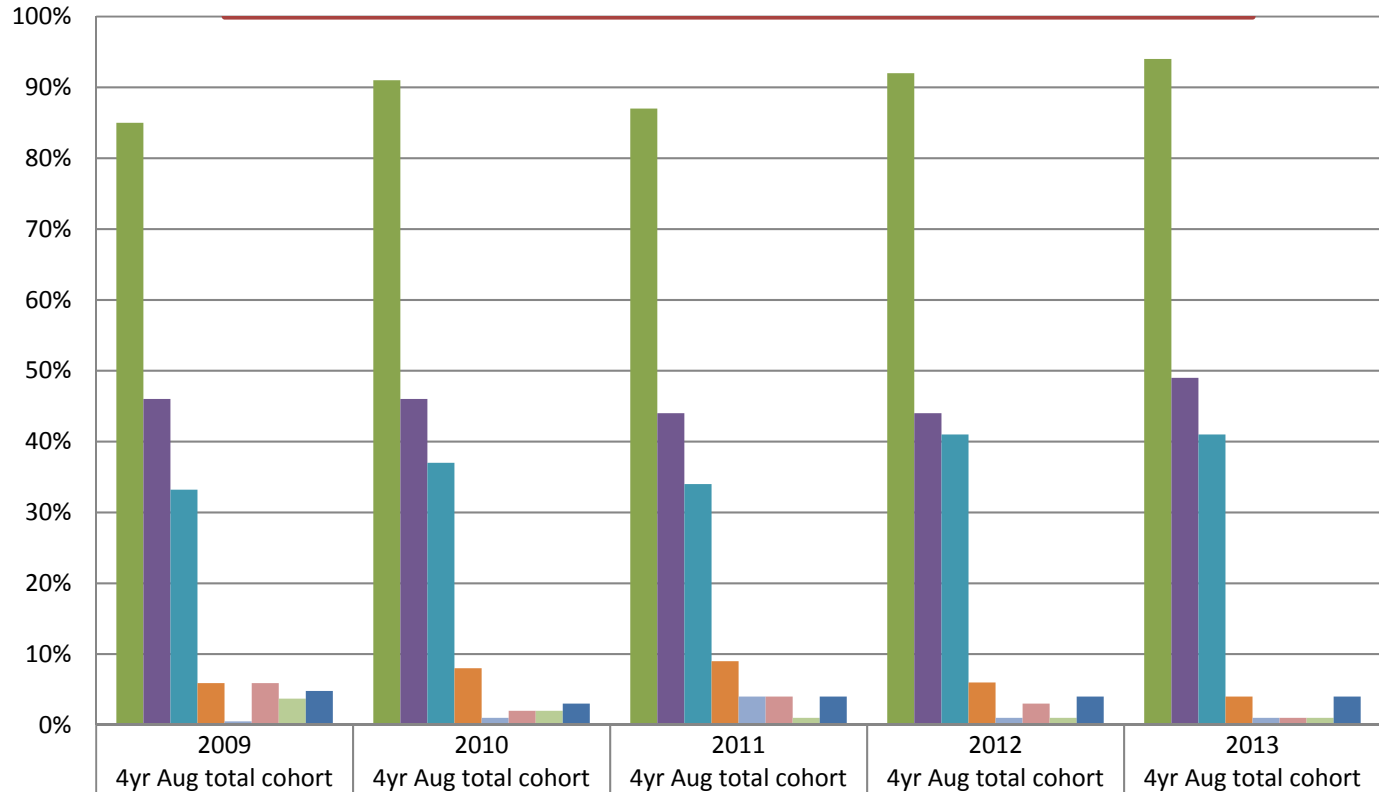

Regents with Advanced Designation - 5 years of data

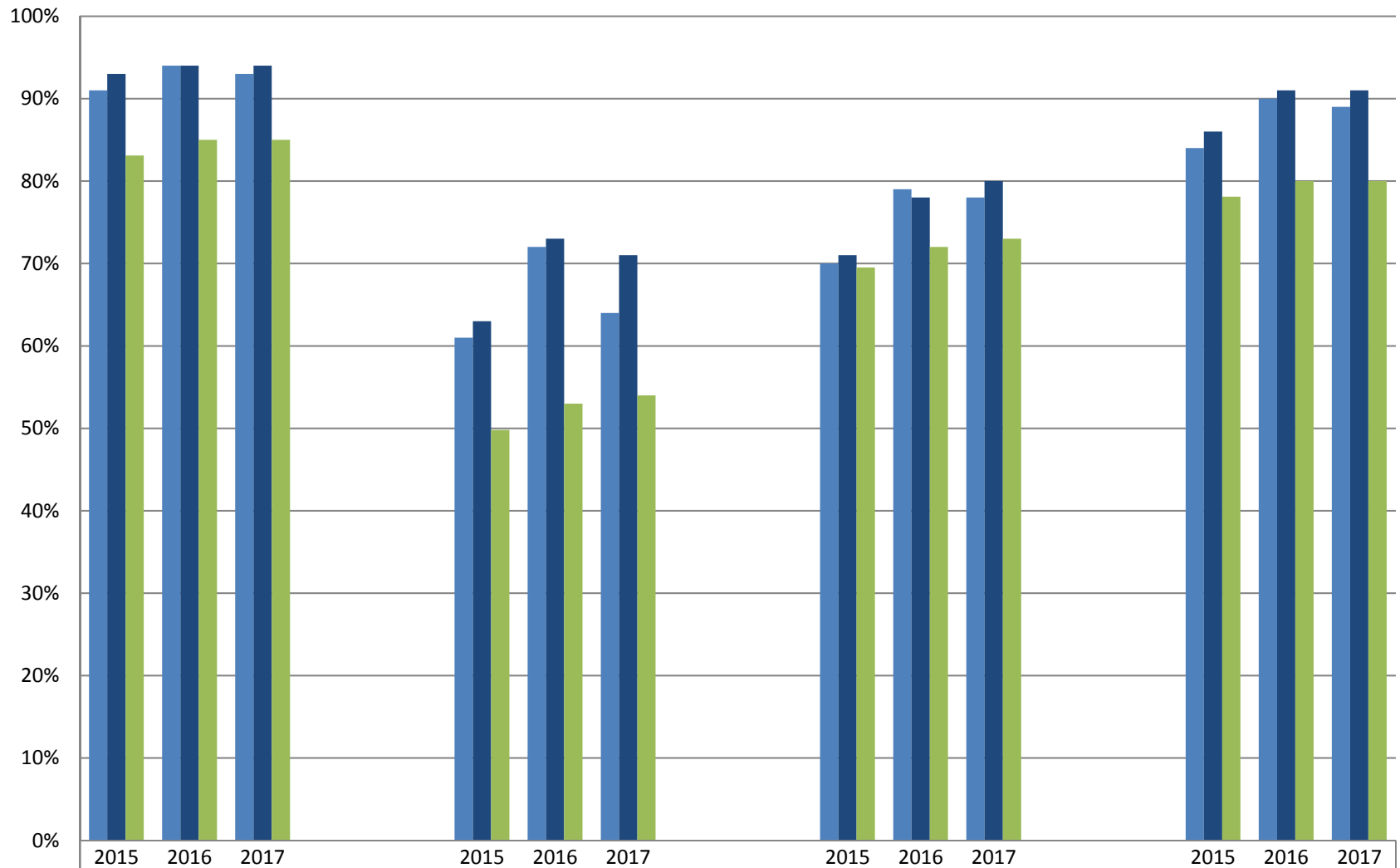


Homer CSD - Total Cohort Graduation Rate and Enrollment Outcome 5 yrs of data



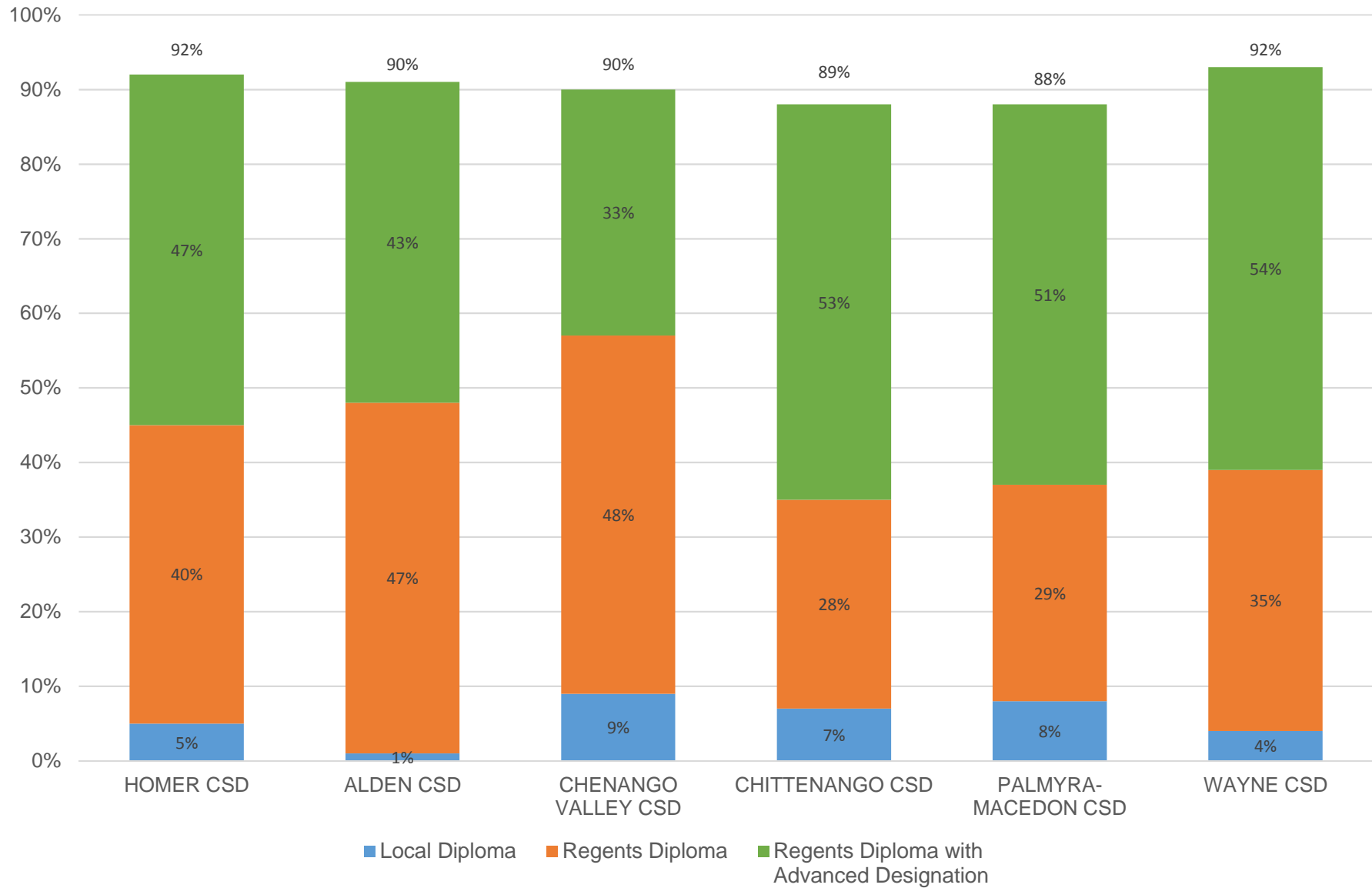

Graduation by Subgroup - June 4yr cohort rates

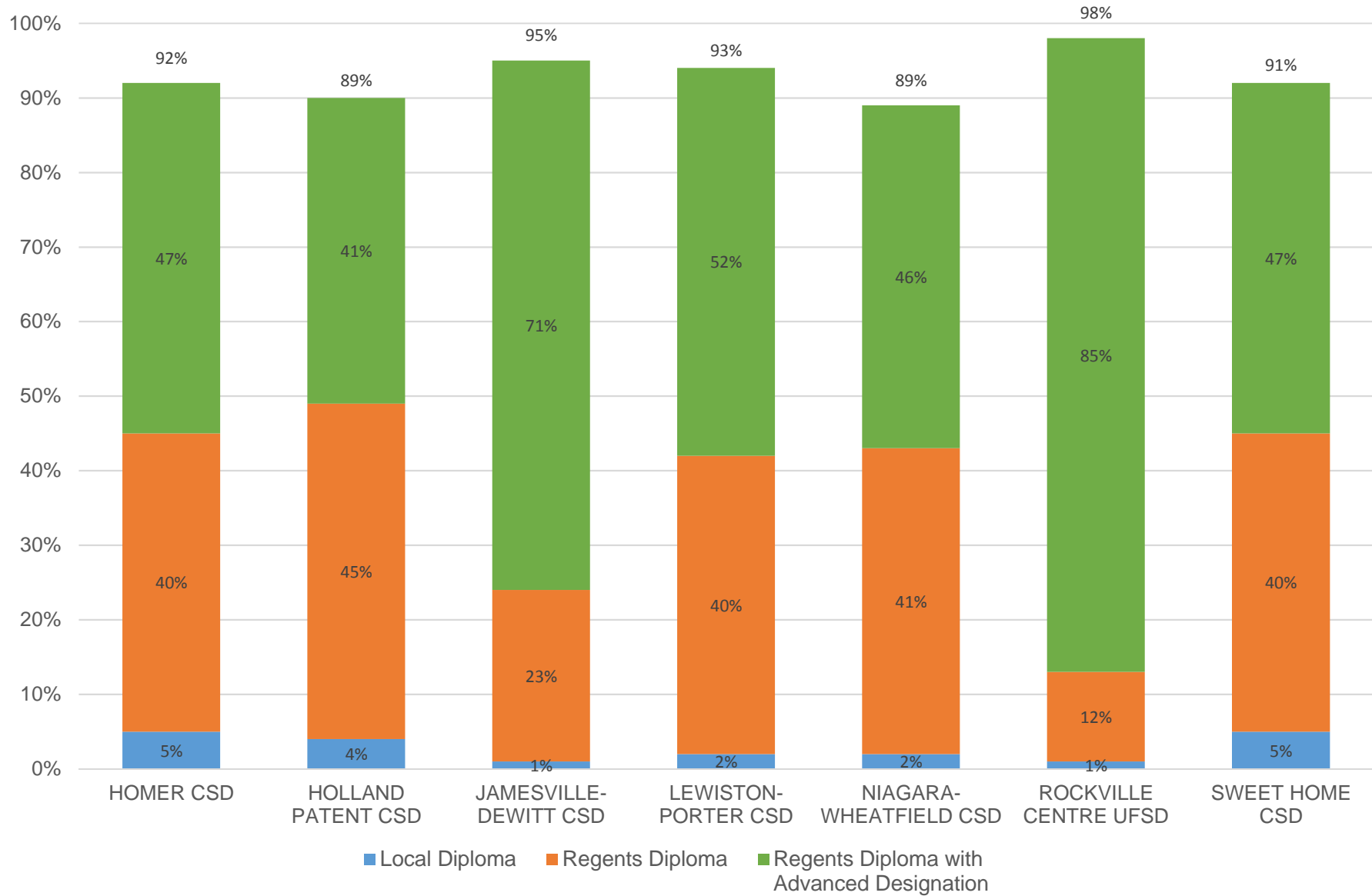

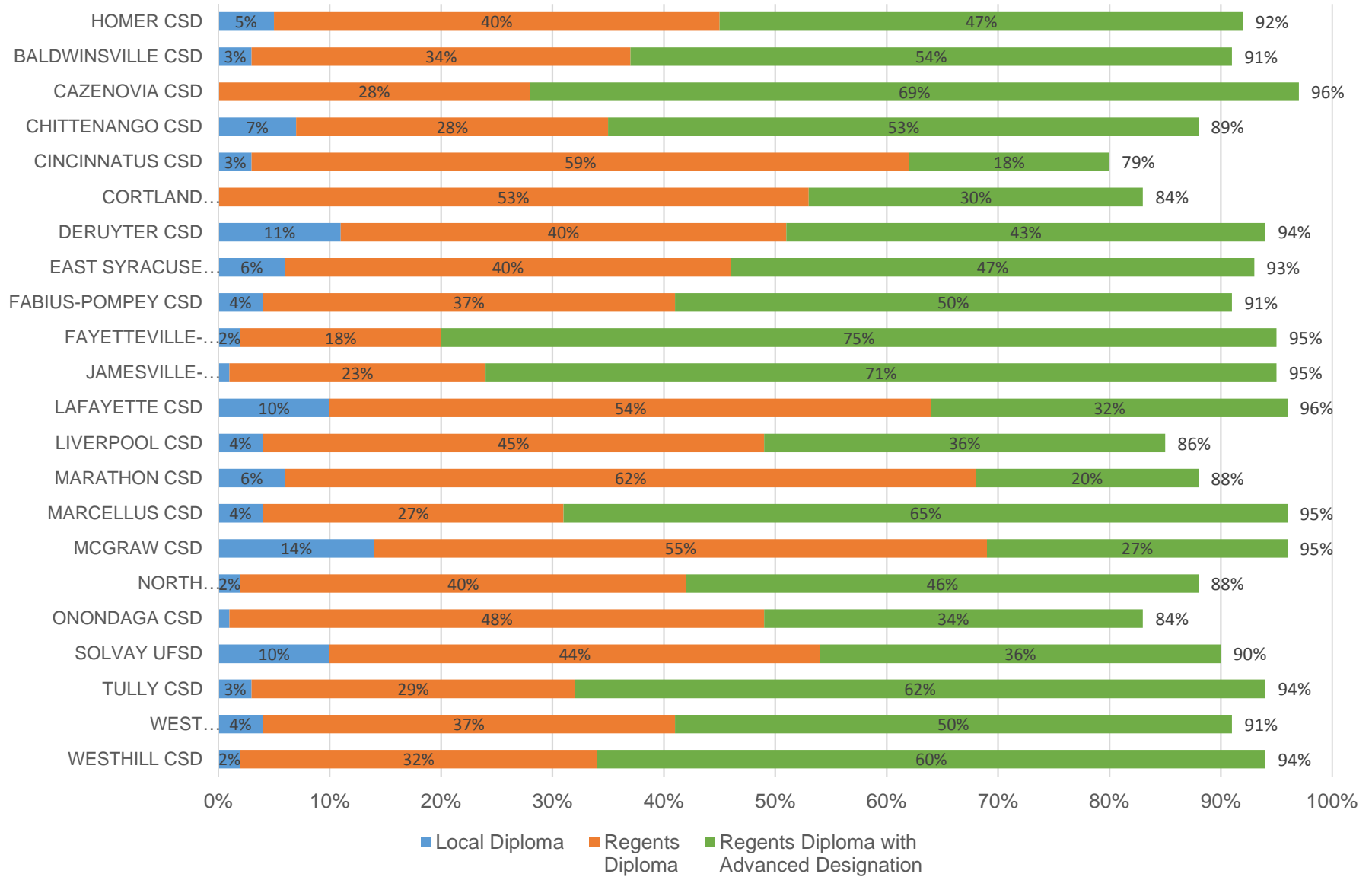
Homer vs. Comparison Districts Graduation Rate - 2017 (Aug 4yr total cohort)
